#### A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Judge Cliff Jolliff on his outstanding public service; and for  
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Judge Cliff Jolliff faithfully served on the Hall County Juvenile Court for 24  
4 years from 1992 to 2014; and

5 WHEREAS, he has long been recognized by the citizens of this state for the vital role that  
6 he has played in leadership and his deep personal commitment to the welfare of the citizens  
7 of Georgia; and

8 WHEREAS, his significant organizational and leadership talents, his remarkable patience  
9 and diplomacy, his keen sense of vision, and his sensitivity to the needs of the citizens of this  
10 state have earned him the respect and admiration of his colleagues and associates; and

11 WHEREAS, he received an A.A. degree from Oxford College of Emory University in 1973,  
12 a B.A. in philosophy from the University of Florida in 1975, and his J.D. degree from the  
13 Walter F. George School of Law at Mercer University in 1978; and

14 WHEREAS, he worked as an attorney in a private practice from 1978 to 1992; in 1990, he  
15 was appointed a part-time judge for the juvenile court and became a full-time judge two  
16 years later; and

17 WHEREAS, Judge Jolliff was former president of the Georgia Council of Juvenile Court  
18 Judges, an appointed member of the Georgia Commission on Family Violence, an appointed  
19 member of the Supreme Court Child Placement Project, and a member of the Judicial  
20 Council of Georgia; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this  
22 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
24 commend Judge Cliff Jolliff.
