

Senate Resolution 130

A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Cadet Jonathan Chase Strickland of the University of North Georgia; and for
2 other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in the United States Army's 2014 National Order of Merit List, which ranked
4 more than 5,617 Army ROTC cadets, Cadet Jonathan Chase Strickland excelled as the top
5 Army ROTC cadet in the nation and is United States Army Cadet Command's Cadet of the
6 Year, based on performances at the Army's Leadership Development Assessment Course,
7 physical fitness, campus leadership performance, and academic achievement; and

8 WHEREAS, Strickland, a native of Gainesville, Georgia, is majoring in International Affairs
9 with a Middle East concentration and will commission as a second lieutenant in military
10 intelligence upon graduation in the spring of 2015; and

11 WHEREAS, as part of his educational experience through the University of North Georgia,
12 Strickland has studied abroad at the NATO Defense War College in Rome, Italy; and

13 WHEREAS, a soldier in the Georgia Army National Guard, Strickland won the "Best
14 Warrior of the 48th Brigade" competition in 2013; and

15 WHEREAS, the University of North Georgia will commission 83 officers in 2015, a record
16 high number, and nearly a third of those cadets finished in the top 20 percent of the National
17 Order of Merit List, earning the status of Distinguished Military Graduate, while five of those
18 UNG cadets finished in the top 10 percent in the national rankings; and

19 WHEREAS, the University of North Georgia, founded in 1873, is the state's second-oldest
20 public institution of higher education and is one of only six senior military colleges in the
21 nation; and

22 WHEREAS, the University of North Georgia is designated by state legislation as The
23 Military College of Georgia and by the Board of Regents of the University System of
24 Georgia as a state leadership institution for civilian and military students; and

25 WHEREAS, the University of North Georgia earned the prestigious MacArthur Award in
26 1991, 1995, and 2010, in recognition of outstanding performance as an Army ROTC
27 program, based on the ideals of the late General Douglas MacArthur.

28 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
29 commend Cadet Jonathan Chase Strickland as the number one cadet in the nation.

30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
31 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Cadet Jonathan
32 Chase Strickland.
