#### A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Amanda Miliner, a former Miss Georgia, for her accomplishment of winning  
2 the 2015 Georgia Teacher of the Year award; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, in 2006, Miliner was named Miss Georgia and, in 2008, she won the honor of  
4 being named Miss Georgia USA; and

5 WHEREAS, Miliner later became a fourth-grade teacher at Miller Elementary School in  
6 Houston County; and

7 WHEREAS, she has been named the 2015 Georgia Teacher of the Year and has been entered  
8 into the National Teacher of the Year competition; and

9 WHEREAS, she has won gifts from such organizations as the Georgia Foundation for Public  
10 Education and the Professional Association of Georgia Educators; and

11 WHEREAS, Miliner's work as a host teacher for a math early intervention program has  
12 reaped noticeable benefits, among them the fact that her class has for several years had a 100  
13 percent pass rate on the math portion of the Criterion-Referenced Competency Test; and

14 WHEREAS, as Georgia's Teacher of the Year, Miliner will travel the state to serve as an  
15 ambassador for education.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
17 commend Amanda Miliner for being chosen as the 2015 Georgia Teacher of the Year.
