- 1 Commending John Peyson Drinkard, Sr.; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, John Peyson Drinkard, Sr., was born on June 8, 1898, in Lincolnton, Georgia,
- 3 and lived a life of community and state service until his passing on July 21, 1960; and
- 4 WHEREAS, Mr. Drinkard launched his long career of public service in the field of
- 5 journalism in 1914, while in his early teens, writing the *Drinkardville News* from a handmade
- 6 desk in his home; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Mr. Drinkard was hired as an employee of the *Lincoln Journal* in 1920, then
- 8 became its owner and editor in 1924; and
- 9 WHEREAS, throughout years of prosperity and depression, sickness and health, his utmost
- desire was to be of service to Lincoln County and the people he loved through the *Lincoln*

- 12 WHEREAS, Mr. Drinkard was a legislator for 18 years, serving in the Georgia House of
- 13 Representatives from 1937 until 1956 and the Georgia State Senate from 1945 until 1958;

- 15 WHEREAS, he was an official delegate at the inauguration of President Truman in 1949 and
- an official delegate to the Democratic National Convention in Chicago in 1956; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Mr. Drinkard received the Outstanding Citizen Award for Lincoln County in
- 18 1954, which was presented by the Woodmen of the World; and
- 19 WHEREAS, he was a Mason and received a 25 year membership pin from the Lincolnton

- 25 August 22, 1948, and was blessed with five remarkable children, Helen Drinkard Turner,
