A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Corporal Craig Fulghum of the Georgia Department of Natural Resources Law
2 Enforcement Division on being named Ranger of the Year for Region II; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, in 2004, Craig Fulghum was promoted to Corporal for exemplifying the
5 character traits desirable in any law enforcement officer and was thereupon assigned to Lake
6 Hartwell as a boating safety officer; and

7 WHEREAS, over the past year, he has presented 44 Information and Education programs;

9 WHEREAS, Corporal Fulghum was elected President of the Fraternal Order of Police
10 Georgia Ranger Lodge in May, and he will assist Rangers with pay parity and other
11 legislative issues; and

12 WHEREAS, in his free time, Corporal Fulghum is involved with the Outdoor Dream
13 Foundation, which grants terminally ill children hunting and fishing trips; and

14 WHEREAS, he also participates with the Junior Athletic League for underprivileged children
15 in Franklin County by teaching boating safety and giving every child who attends a life
16 jacket; and

17 WHEREAS, Corporal Fulghum has been involved in and helped design many other
18 programs that are both self-sustaining and helpful to his community.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
20 the members of this body commend Corporal Craig Fulghum on being named Ranger of the
21 Year for Region II.
