A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the League of Women Voters of Georgia and the affiliated local Leagues in
2 the State of Georgia on the occasion of their 95th anniversary and recognizing February 18,
3 2015, as League of Women Voters of Georgia Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters was founded on February 14, 1920, as a
5 volunteer, nonpartisan organization to promote political responsibility through informed and
6 active participation of citizens in their government; and

7 WHEREAS, the League of Women Voters of Georgia and the affiliated local Leagues in the
8 State of Georgia are widely recognized as exerting a positive influence on government at all
9 levels and being instrumental in encouraging voter registration and participation; and

10 WHEREAS, the diligent efforts of the League of Women Voters of Georgia have earned the
11 organization a well-deserved reputation as one of the most beneficial and influential political
12 organizations in this state; and

13 WHEREAS, throughout its 95 years, the League has continuously and consistently worked
14 for responsible and responsive government at the local, state, and national levels; and

15 WHEREAS, the commitment and dedication of the League of Women Voters and its
16 members have been amply demonstrated in its 95 years; and

17 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding work of this fine
18 organization and its numerous contributions to the citizens of this state be appropriately
19 recognized.

20 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
21 commend the League of Women Voters of Georgia and the affiliated local Leagues for 95

22 years of service to the people of the State of Georgia and recognize February 18, 2015, as
23 League of Women Voters of Georgia Day at the capitol.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
25 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the League of
26 Women Voters of Georgia.
