A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 15-16-21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees  
2 for sheriff's services, so as to provide for the sheriff to collect and deposit certain fees; to  
3 provide for an effective date; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

5 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

6 Code Section 15-16-21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to fees for  
7 sheriff's services, is amended by revising subsection (a) to read as follows:

8 "~~(a) Reserved.~~ In all counties in this state where the sheriff is paid on a salary only, this  
9 Code section shall apply as far as fees to be charged, but all such fees shall be turned over  
10 to the county treasurer or fiscal officer of the county."

11 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

12 This Act shall become effective upon its approval by the Governor or upon its becoming law  
13 without such approval.

15 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
