A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Calhoun High School competition cheerleading team for winning the 2014
2 AAA State Championship Title and inviting them to be recognized by the House of
3 Representatives; and for other purposes.

4 WHEREAS, through perseverance and determination, the Calhoun High School Yellow
5 Jackets gained their first competition cheerleading AAA State Championship Title after
6 unseating the two-time defending state champion, Pierce County; and

7 WHEREAS, this team moved up in reclassification from AA to AAA after winning five AA
8 State Championship Titles, including the 2013 AA State Championship Title in competition
9 cheerleading; and

10 WHEREAS, the Yellow Jackets overcame many challenges during the 2014 season, and by
11 their dedication, determination, and hard work, this team was able to come out on top during
12 their first season competing in the AAA classification; and

13 WHEREAS, the performance of the team is a clear indication of the outstanding talent
14 possessed by these cheerleaders, as well as the unity of purpose and spirit that each of them
15 holds, including their outstanding coach, Ginger Griffith Reeves; and

16 WHEREAS, Coach Ginger Reeves is a six-time state championship coach and a special
17 education teacher at Calhoun Middle School, where she has served since 1992; and

18 WHEREAS, this team earned its well-deserved reputation for excellence by performing with
19 courage and precision over months of training and competition, making it proper to call them
20 champions.

21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
22 the members of this body commend the Calhoun High School competition cheerleading team

23 for winning the 2014 AAA State Championship Title and invite them to be recognized by

25 House of Representatives.
