3 States and won first place in the 13th FIPS Mouche Youth World Fly Fishing Championships
4 in Nowy Sacz, Poland, in June, 2014, beating out competitors from all over the world; and

5 WHEREAS, four of the six team members hail from our great State of Georgia, and all
6 equally contributed to the team's success; and

7 WHEREAS, Gabriel Wittosch from Atlanta, Georgia, won the individual gold, leading the
8 team to its first place victory; and

9 WHEREAS, Hunter Hoffler from Moreland, Georgia, placed sixth in the individual results;

11 WHEREAS, Mason Sims from Chickamauga, Georgia, placed seventh in the individual
12 results; and

13 WHEREAS, Andrew Brown from Alpharetta, Georgia, proudly represented Georgia and the
14 United States in this most esteemed of international competitions; and

15 WHEREAS, Cam Chioffi from Weston, Massachusetts, finished second in the individual
16 competition, and Hunter Enloe from Hudson, North Carolina, finished fourth in the
17 individual competition; and

18 WHEREAS, Coaches Paul Bourcq and Chris Smith are to be congratulated for their
19 contributions to this achievement and are sure to lead the team to great success in the 2015
20 World Championships in Vail, Colorado, in August, 2015; and

21 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the extraordinary accomplishments of
22 these distinguished Georgians be appropriately recognized.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
