## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 37-2-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the
- 2 Behavioral Health Coordinating Council, membership, meetings and obligations, so as to
- 3 provide for two additional members to serve on the behavioral health coordinating council;
- 4 to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 37-2-4 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to the Behavioral
- 8 Health Coordinating Council, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows:
- 9 "(a) There is created the Behavioral Health Coordinating Council. The council shall
- 10 consist of the commissioner of behavioral health and developmental disabilities; the
- 11 commissioner of community health; the commissioner of public health; the commissioner
- of human services; the commissioner of juvenile justice; the commissioner of corrections;
- the commissioner of community affairs; the Commissioner of Labor; the State School
- Superintendent; the chairperson of the State Board of Pardons and Paroles; the executive
- director of the Governor's Office of Student Achievement; the deputy commissioner of the
- 16 Workforce Division of the Georgia Department of Economic Development; the
- ombudsman appointed pursuant to Code Section 37-2-32; an adult consumer of public
- behavioral health services, appointed by the Governor; a family member of a consumer of
- public behavioral health services, appointed by the Governor; a parent of a child receiving
- public behavioral health services, appointed by the Governor; a member of the House of
- Representatives, appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives; and a member
- of the Senate, appointed by the Lieutenant Governor."

SECTION 2.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
