

ADOPTED

Senators Shafer of the 48th and Unterman of the 45th offered the following amendment:

1 *Amend the Senate Health and Human Services Committee substitute to SB 3(LC 37*
2 *1898ERS) by deleting lines 77 through 81.*

3 *By deleting lines 106 and 107 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*

4 (b) A parent shall not execute a power of attorney for the care of a minor child for the
5 purpose of subverting an investigation of the child's welfare initiated by the Division of
6 Family and Children Services of the Department of Human Services and shall not execute
7 such power of attorney so long as the Division of Family and Children Services has an
8 open child welfare and youth services case with regard to the parent, the child, or another
9 child of the parent.

10 (c) The power of attorney for the care of a child shall be signed and acknowledged before
11 a notary public by the parent executing the power of attorney.
