## A RESOLUTION

35 of the 2014-2015 4-H district presidents; 2014 Dean's Awards winners; 2014 National 4-H

37 Preparation Demonstration Contest winner; 2014 National Shooting Sports Invitational First  
38 Place winner for their numerous accomplishments and for the leadership that they have  
39 demonstrated, and invite Mr. Ben Hancock, Mr. Arch D. Smith, and each of the 4-H leaders  
40 and members named in this resolution to be recognized by the House of Representatives at  
41 a date and time to be determined by the Speaker of the House of Representatives.
