- 2 budget, with such limitation based upon changes in the Consumer Price Index and population
- 3 growth; to provide for the submission of this amendment for ratification or rejection; and for

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

7 Article III, Section IX, Paragraph IV of the Constitution is amended by adding a new

8 subparagraph to read as follows:

"(e)(1) The General Assembly shall not appropriate state funds for any given fiscal year

which, in the aggregate, exceed the aggregate amount of state funds appropriated for the

immediately preceding fiscal year plus a percentage increase in such appropriation over

the appropriation for the immediately preceding fiscal year which does not exceed the

percentage increase in gross state product for the most recently available year over the

gross state product for the immediately preceding year. For purposes of this

subparagraph, the percentage increase in gross state product shall be determined by the

16 Consumer Price Index as reported by the Bureau of Labor Statistics of the United States

Department of Labor plus the annual percentage increase in the total population of this

state according to the United States Bureau of the Census. Should the gross state product

decline, this subparagraph shall not require aggregate appropriated state funds to be

reduced. The General Assembly may exceed the limitation of this subparagraph only if

a joint resolution specifically authorizing the expenditure of additional funds is approved

by a two-thirds' vote of both houses of the General Assembly. Such resolution shall be

limited to the expenditure of additional funds and no other issues shall be contained in

24 <u>the resolution.</u>

25 (2) In the event the revenue received by the state exceeds the amount necessary to fund

26 <u>appropriations as provided in subparagraph (1) of this subparagraph and the reserve fund,</u>

27 such excess shall be refunded to the citizens of this state who have paid income tax in the

previous year. The General Assembly is authorized to establish the method for payment

and allocation of the income tax rebate by general law." 29 30 **SECTION 2.** The above proposed amendment to the Constitution shall be published and submitted as 31 32 provided in Article X, Section I, Paragraph II of the Constitution. The ballot submitting the above proposed amendment shall have written or printed thereon the following: 33 34 "() YES Shall the Constitution of Georgia be amended so as to limit the rate of () NO 35 growth in the state budget, with such limitation based upon changes in the Consumer Price Index and population growth?" 36

- 37 All persons desiring to vote in favor of ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "Yes."
- 38 All persons desiring to vote against ratifying the proposed amendment shall vote "No." If
- 39 such amendment shall be ratified as provided in said Paragraph of the Constitution, it shall
- 40 become a part of the Constitution of this state.
