- 4 WHEREAS, a candidate for the most exceptional award in scouting must complete a
5 rigorous program of training and demonstrate his proficiency in selected scouting techniques
6 and attainment of the highest ideals of scouting; and
- 7 WHEREAS, only one scout out of 97 ever reaches this lofty level of achievement, and
8 Nathaniel has ably evidenced his aptitude and competency in mastering the various special
9 skills taught through the Boy Scout program; and
- 10 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 705 and has demonstrated
11 great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of America
12 program; and
- 13 WHEREAS, he has spent ten years in the Boy Scout organization as a member of Tiger
14 Scouts, Cub Scouts, Bear Scouts, Webelos, and Boy Scouts; and
- 15 WHEREAS, he has been awarded 24 merit badges and was a part of Troop 705's river
16 clean-up project that won them the Coca-Cola Award in 2011; and
- 17 WHEREAS, his Eagle project included repairing a retaining wall, installing new hand rails
18 in the parking lot, pressure washing the building and concrete, and cleaning and painting the
19 BBQ pit area at the Masonic Lodge in Monroe, Georgia, Generous Warren Lodge #20; and

20 WHEREAS, an outstanding Georgian, Nathaniel has truly exhibited a commitment to the
21 scouting principles of honesty and fairness and has consistently conducted himself in a
22 manner becoming an Eagle Scout; and

23 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
24 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

25 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
26 the members of this body commend Nathaniel Curtis Aschwege for his diligence and
27 dedication in pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and
