A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing and commending the rich cultural history of the Cross Roads School; and for
- 2 other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, the Cross Roads School was originally a part of the Cross Roads Community,
- 4 which was a small, rural settlement established in the 1870s by African-American freedmen
- 5 and farm workers at the junction of Harmony Grove-Athens Road (now U.S. Highway 441)
- 6 and the Jefferson-Danielsville Road; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the Cross Roads Community was composed of a one-room school building, the
- 8 Cross Roads A.M.E. Church, and a cemetery; and
- 9 WHEREAS, the Cross Roads School held classes as early as 1879 under the instruction of
- 10 Cicero Buffington, and it was one of only three schools for African-American children in the
- 11 Nicholson, Georgia, area during the late 19th century; and
- 12 WHEREAS, the school was awarded academic and financial support by the Negro Rural
- 13 School Fund, also known as the Jeanes Fund, in 1912; and
- 14 WHEREAS, the Cross Roads School building held classes for students in the first through
- eighth grades, and average attendance ranged from 30 to 80 pupils, depending upon the
- 16 farming season; and
- 17 WHEREAS, the Cross Roads School was closed in the mid-1940s, and the building was used
- as an agricultural outbuilding and later sat vacant before it was donated to the Tumbling
- 19 Waters Society and Jackson County Parks and Recreation on February 4, 2013; and
- 20 WHEREAS, the school building was moved to Heritage Village at Hurricane Shoals Park
- and was restored and opened to the public on September 15, 2013; and

22 WHEREAS, the Cross Roads School Historical Marker will be dedicated on February 22,

- 23 2015; and
- 24 WHEREAS, this historical marker is dedicated to the families, students, and teachers who
- 25 attended and taught at Cross Roads School from 1879 through the mid-1940s, and this body
- 26 honors and remembers their many contributions to the State of Georgia.
- 27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 28 the members of this body recognize and commend the rich cultural history of the Cross
- 29 Roads School.
- 30 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 31 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to Mayor
- 32 Ronnie Maxwell, the Jackson County Board of Commissioners, the Jackson County Parks
- 33 and Recreation Department, the Tumbling Waters Society of Jackson County, the Cross
- 34 Roads Committee, and Representative Tommy Benton.
