1 Recognizing and commending the Irwin County Senior 4-H Poultry Judging Team; and for

4 from nine to 19 years of age to learn valuable lessons outside the classroom and offer some
5 55 project areas in which students can develop expertise and compete with one another; and

14 WHEREAS, team captain and Georgia State 4-H President Ben Hancock was the high
15 individual overall at the national contest; and

16 WHEREAS, members of the Irwin County 4-H Poultry Judging Team are outstanding
17 representatives of the dynamic resource this state has in its young people.

18 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
19 recognize and commend 4-H members Ben Hancock, Guy Hancock, James Hancock, and
20 La'Lonnice Jackson as the award-winning Senior 4-H Poultry Judging Team.
