A RESOLUTION

1 Commending C.J. Pearson, a 12 year old from Grovetown, Georgia, who is the founder and
2 Executive Director of Young Georgians in Government; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, he is the founder and Executive Director of Young Georgians in Government,
4 a nonpartisan group with teen field representatives in 15 counties across this state; and

5 WHEREAS, C.J. has authored a piece of legislation, the Young Georgians in Government
6 Act of 2015, which proposes to lower the minimum age to run for a Georgia Senate seat from
7 25 to 21 and to lower the minimum age to run for a Georgia House of Representatives seat
8 from 21 to 18; and

9 WHEREAS, C.J. is a Republican with Libertarian leanings, but he says that his strongest
10 guiding force is the vision of the United States founding fathers; and

11 WHEREAS, he believes in limited government and feels passionately that protecting the
12 health and future of Georgia's young people are vital to the future of this state; and

13 WHEREAS, C.J. Pearson is an intelligent, determined, and hard-working young man, and
14 success is surely in his future.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
16 the members of this body commend C.J. Pearson, founder and Executive Director of Young
17 Georgians in Government.
