A RESOLUTION

- 1 Commending His Royal Majesty Oba Adejuyigbe Egundjobi Alladohonu Oyewole
- 2 Adefunmi II; and for other purposes.
- 3 WHEREAS, His Royal Majesty Oba Adejuyigbe Egundjobi Alladohonu Oyewole Adefunmi
- 4 II, born December 21, 1976, to His Royal Highness Oba Efuntola Adefunmi I and Iya Esu
- 5 Ogo Oyewole, is the King of the Yoruba people in North America; and
- 6 WHEREAS, he was raised in the Kingdom of Oyotunji African Village, where he was
- 7 entrenched in the traditions and culture of his ancestors and rooted in the traditional lifestyle
- 8 of that village; and
- 9 WHEREAS, an accomplished drummer, he began drumming at the young age of seven and
- 10 has given many national and international performances; and
- 11 WHEREAS, by the time he graduated from the Yoruba Royal Academy, King Adejuyigbe
- 12 Adefunmi II was an initiate of several sacred Egbes (African societies), including Egbe
- 13 Egungun, Egbe Obatala, Egbe Onilu ayan, Egbe Akinkonju, and Igbodu, the society of the
- 14 Fathers of Mystery in the worship of Orunmila; and
- 15 WHEREAS, his wide array of entrepreneurial skills and years of hard work and training in
- 16 carpentry and administration on Dopkwe, the state work force, led to the creation of the
- 17 "Royal Tribe Stucco Design" company; and
- 18 WHEREAS, he moved to Key West, Florida, in 2001, where he was an artist in residency
- 19 at the Lofton B. Sands African Bahamian Museum; and
- 20 WHEREAS, he was instrumental in the design and construction of the African Exhibit at the
- 21 Lofton B. Sands African Bahamian Museum, made many valuable contributions to the

22 education and cultural expansion of the African American population in Key West, and gave

- 23 daily lectures to students from the schools in Monroe County, Florida; and
- 24 WHEREAS, he became the King of Oyotunji on July 3, 2005, and he aspires to increase the
- 25 practical value for ancient traditions today to all peoples and cultures of the world.
- 26 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 27 the members of this body commend His Royal Majesty Oba Adejuyigbe Egundjobi
- 28 Alladohonu Oyewole Adefunmi II, King of the Yoruba people in North America.
- 29 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
- 30 and directed to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to His
