A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing Tuesday, February 24, 2015, as Math Day at the capitol; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, the Georgia Council of Teachers of Mathematics (GCTM) is an affiliate of the
3 National Council of Teachers of Mathematics and is composed of classroom teachers from
4 preschool to graduate school in addition to nonteachers who share an interest in mathematics
5 education in the State of Georgia; and

6 WHEREAS, the mission of GCTM is to promote a high quality mathematics education for
7 all students, encourage an active interest in mathematics and mathematics education, promote
8 ongoing professional development for mathematics education, and reward excellence in the
9 teaching of mathematics in the State of Georgia; and

10 WHEREAS, one of the fundamental objectives of GCTM is to act as an advocate for the
11 improvement of mathematics education at all levels in Georgia; and

12 WHEREAS, as part of this mission, GCTM hopes that Math Day at the capitol will promote
13 the importance of mathematics education in Georgia and highlight the connection between
14 mathematically literate citizens and economic development.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
16 recognize Tuesday, February 24, 2015, as Math Day at the capitol in order to increase
17 awareness about the importance of mathematics education for the future of the State of
18 Georgia.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed
20 to make an appropriate copy of this resolution available for distribution to the Georgia
21 Council of Teachers of Mathematics.
