A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 general provisions for payment and disposition of fines and forfeitures, so as to provide for
- 3 the collection of delinquent fines and statutory surcharges; to provide for a definition; to
- 4 provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 21 of Title 15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to general
- 8 provisions for payment and disposition of fines and forfeitures, is amended by revising Code
- 9 Section 15-21-12, which was previously reserved, as follows:
- 10 "15-21-12.
- 11 Reserved.
- 12 (a) As used in this Code section, the term 'fines and fees' means a fine imposed by a court
- under the authority of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated and all statutory surcharges
- 14 attached to such fine.
- 15 (b) A local governing authority may, for the purpose of collecting any delinquent fines and
- 16 fees, contract with any person doing business within or outside this state for the collection
- of such delinquent fines and fees."

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
