A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending Chase Beckman; and for other purposes.

2 WHEREAS, Chase Beckman has attained the rank of Eagle Scout, the most distinguished
3 rank conferred by the Boy Scouts of America; and

4 WHEREAS, this hard-working young man is a member of Troop 143 in Johns Creek and has
5 demonstrated great leadership skills and initiative during his years with the Boy Scouts of
6 America program and served as Senior Patrol Leader and crew leader for the Philmont High
7 Adventure Trek in New Mexico; and

8 WHEREAS, for his service project, Chase built four eight-foot picnic tables for The Vine
9 Community Church and raised \$780.00, of which \$624.84 was used for materials and the
10 remainder was donated to the church; he spent 96 hours on the project and 19 volunteers
11 spent an additional 123 volunteer hours on the project for a total of 219 hours; and

12 WHEREAS, Chase is also very active in his church where he has raised money and gone on
13 a mission trip to Haiti; and

14 WHEREAS, the perseverance and determination displayed by this exceptional young leader
15 is an example for all Georgians, and great success is surely in this young man's future.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body commend Chase Beckman for his diligence and dedication in
18 pursuing the highest honor awarded by the Boy Scouts of America and congratulate him on
19 attaining the prestigious rank of Eagle Scout.
