## A RESOLUTION

1 Honoring the staff and students of Cornelia Elementary School for being named a 2014  
2 Georgia Department of Education Reward School in the category of Highest Progress; and

5 making the most progress in improving the performance of the "all students" group over  
6 three years on the statewide assessments; and

10 expectations for students exists at Cornelia Elementary School; and
