A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Kelley O'Hara for being named as part of the U.S. Women's National Soccer
2 Team; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Kelley O'Hara is a proud Georgia native and was born and raised in
4 Fayetteville, Georgia; and

5 WHEREAS, while playing for the youth club AFC Lightning, she joined the U.S. Under-17
6 National Team; and

7 WHEREAS, during her distinguished career as a high school athlete at Starr's Mill High
8 School, she was named to the All-State team for four years in a row; and

9 WHEREAS, she was also named 2006 Atlanta Journal-Constitution Player of the Year and
10 Gatorade Georgia State Player of the Year; and

11 WHEREAS, she attended Stanford University where she set school records for goals and
12 assists and was awarded the 2009 Hermann Trophy as college soccer's player of the year; and

13 WHEREAS, she plays professionally for Sky Blue Football Club in the National Women's
14 Soccer League; and

15 WHEREAS, Kelley has played over 50 times for the U.S. Women's National Team and will
16 be playing in her second World Cup this summer in Canada.

17 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
18 commend Kelley O'Hara for being named as part of the U.S. Women's National Soccer Team
19 and recognize her outstanding athletic achievements.
