A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 definitions for juvenile proceedings under the Juvenile Code, so as to provide that minor 3 violations of weapons in school safety zones are not considered Class B designated felonies; 4 to restore certain provisions to their prior form due to the conflict between the enactment of 5 2014 House Bill 60 and House Bill 826; to provide for an effective date and applicability; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes. 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 7 8 **SECTION 1.** 9 Code Section 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions for 10 juvenile proceedings, is amended by revising subparagraph (N) of paragraph (13) as follows: 11 "(N)(i) An act which constitutes a violation of Code Section 16-11-127.1 involving: 12 (I) A firearm, as defined in paragraph (2) of subsection (a) of Code Section 13 <u>16-11-131;</u> 14 (II) A dangerous weapon or machine gun, as defined in Code Section 16-11-121; 15 <u>or</u> 16 (III) Any weapon, as defined in Code Section 16-11-127.1, together with an 17 assault; or

- (ii) An act which constitutes a second or subsequent adjudication of delinquency
 based on a violation of Code Section 16-11-127.1; or"
- This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015, and shall apply to acts committed on and after July 1, 2015.
