A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
2 definitions for juvenile proceedings under the Juvenile Code, so as to provide that minor
3 violations of weapons in school safety zones are not considered Class B designated felonies;
4 to restore certain provisions to their prior form due to the conflict between the enactment of
5 2014 House Bill 60 and House Bill 826; to provide for an effective date and applicability;
6 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 1.**

9 Code Section 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions for
10 juvenile proceedings, is amended by revising subparagraph (N) of paragraph (13) as follows:

11 "(N)(i) An act which constitutes a violation of Code Section 16-11-127.1 involving:
12 (I) A firearm, as defined in paragraph (2) of subsection (a) of Code Section
13 16-11-131;
14 (II) A dangerous weapon or machine gun, as defined in Code Section 16-11-121;
15 or
16 (III) Any weapon, as defined in Code Section 16-11-127.1, together with an
17 assault; or
18 (ii) An act which constitutes a second or subsequent adjudication of delinquency
19 based on a violation of Code Section 16-11-127.1; or"

20 style="text-align:center">**SECTION 2.**

21 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015, and shall apply to acts committed on and
22 after July 1, 2015.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
