A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend Chapter 5 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ethics
2 in government, so as to prohibit the use of government supplied e-mail addresses for
3 campaign purposes; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other
4 purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 Chapter 5 of Title 21 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to ethics in
8 government, is amended by adding a new subsection to Code Section 21-5-14, relating to
9 e-mail address reporting requirements and exceptions, as follows:

10 "(c) No public official shall use or list his or her government supplied e-mail address for
11 any campaign or election purpose."

13 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
