- 14 WHEREAS, Captain Wilkerson was assigned as Chief of Staff for Commander Naval
- 15 Reserve Readiness Command Region NINE in Memphis, Tennessee, where he earned a
- 16 Masters of Science in Operations Management from the University of Arkansas; and
- 17 WHEREAS, Captain Wilkerson also served as Commanding Officer at the Naval and Marine
- 18 Corps Reserve Center in Atlanta, Georgia, from 1998 to 2001; and
- 19 WHEREAS, after his retirement from active duty in 2002, Captain Wilkerson was employed
- 20 as a Senior Naval Science Instructor for the Forrest City Naval Junior Reserve Officer
- 21 Training Corps in Forrest City, Arkansas; and
