## A RESOLUTION

1 Commending Georgia State University student-athlete Ronald Jordan "R.J." Hunter for  
2 setting the school's all-time men's basketball scoring record; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter is a junior majoring in psychology at Georgia State University and  
4 is a guard in the starting line-up for the Georgia State University men's basketball team; and

5 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter was an outstanding high school basketball player from Pike High  
6 School in Indianapolis, Indiana, and was recruited to play for the Georgia State Panthers by  
7 his father, Georgia State University men's basketball coach, Ron Hunter; and

8 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter is a versatile shooting guard with tremendous range and incredible  
9 ball-handling skills, and he has earned all-conference first team honors twice and was Player  
10 of the Year in the Sun Belt Conference in 2014; and

11 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter earned AP All-American recognition, was a freshman  
12 All-American, and was named the Atlanta Tip-off Club Georgia College Player of the Year  
13 in 2014; and

14 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter is the first Panther to make 100 3-pointers in a season and set a  
15 record of 38 straight free throws in 2014; and

16 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter became the 18th Panther to reach 1,000 career points in just 55  
17 games; and

18 WHEREAS, on January 24, 2015, at the Georgia State Sports Arena in a highly competitive  
19 game against conference rival, University of Louisiana, Lafayette, R.J. Hunter broke the  
20 school record of 1,515 career points, which was set by Rodney Hamilton in 1998; and

21 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter accomplished this record in just 84 college career games and helped  
22 his teammates defeat the Ragin' Cajuns by 75-64; and

23 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter has exhibited exceptional athletic talents along with an unrelenting  
24 commitment to practice, discipline, and perseverance; and

25 WHEREAS, R.J. Hunter continues to be an outstanding ambassador for Georgia State  
26 University Athletics.

27 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that  
28 the members of this body commend Georgia State University men's basketball  
29 student-athlete Ronald Jordan "R.J." Hunter on his exemplary accomplishments and pursuit  
30 of excellence on the basketball court.

31 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized  
32 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the  
33 Georgia State University Athletic Department and student-athlete Ronald Jordan "R.J."
