- WHEREAS, more than 1.2 million Georgians over the age of 18 lack a high school degree;
 and
- 4 WHEREAS, teachers, administrators, and advocates work to provide learning opportunities
- 5 for adults who did not receive a high school diploma; and
- 6 WHEREAS, more than 71,000 adult learners in Georgia utilize these programs annually; and
- WHEREAS, these adult learners commit themselves to bettering the lives of themselves and
 their families, thereby enriching their communities; and
- 9 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that these devoted teachers, administrators,
 10 and advocates, as well as the commitment of the adult learners they serve, should be
 11 appropriately recognized for the benefit they provide to Georgia and its citizens.
- 12 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
- 13 the members of this body recognize February 17, 2015, as Literacy Day at the state capitol;
- 14 commend teachers, administrators, and advocates for their selfless commitment to the
- 15 betterment of humanity; commend adult learners for their commitment to providing a better
- 16 life for themselves and their families; and extend to them their sincere best wishes.
