- 8 throughout the world in many diverse fields of endeavor; and
- 9 WHEREAS, Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., has dedicated its resources to the voter
- 10 registration and education program known as "VOTE OR CRY"; and
- 11 WHEREAS, the first objective of "VOTE OR CRY" is to register as many eligible Georgia
- 12 citizens as possible to vote; and

- 14 eligibility to vote, and other issues related to voting in Georgia; and

- 17 "CRY" when they see the election results; and
- 18 WHEREAS, the men of Omega Psi Phi Fraternity, Inc., will inform and educate Georgia
- 19 citizens to "DIRECT" the voting of their elected officials, "EXPECT" the elected officials
- 20 to keep them informed on developing legislation and administrative changes, and to
