A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

To amend Chapter 9 of Title 25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to blasting or excavating near utility facilities, so as to prohibit local governing authorities from adopting or enforcing ordinances which mandate marking requirements or standards which are different from those contained in state law or the rules and regulations of certain departments of this state; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1. 9 Chapter 9 of Title 25 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to blasting or 10 excavating near utility facilities, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as 11 follows: 12 "25-9-11.1.

13 <u>No local governing authority shall adopt or enforce any resolution or ordinance setting</u>

14 forth requirements or standards as to white lining, marking, re-marking, or any other

15 method of locating utility facilities or sewer laterals which are different from those set forth

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
