A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to general provisions regarding pharmacists and pharmacies, so as to provide that
- 3 certain provisions of law regarding pharmacists and pharmacies shall not apply to a facility
- 4 engaged solely in the distribution of dialysate, drugs, or devices necessary to perform home
- 5 kidney dialysis to patients with end stage renal disease, provided that certain criteria are met;
- 6 to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

8 SECTION 1.

- 9 Article 1 of Chapter 4 of Title 26 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 10 general provisions regarding pharmacists and pharmacies, is amended by adding a new Code
- 11 section to read as follows:
- 12 "26-4-6.
- 13 The provisions of this chapter shall not apply to a facility engaged solely in the distribution
- of dialysate, drugs, or devices necessary to perform home kidney dialysis to patients with
- end stage renal disease, provided that the following criteria are met:
- 16 (1) The dialysate, drugs, or devices are approved or cleared by the federal Food and Drug
- 17 <u>Administration as required by federal law;</u>
- 18 (2) The dialysate, drugs, or devices are lawfully held by a manufacturer or
- manufacturer's agent that is properly registered with the board as a manufacturer or
- wholesale distributor;
- 21 (3) The dialysate, drugs, or devices are held and delivered in their original, sealed
- 22 packaging from the manufacturing facility;
- 23 (4) The dialysate, drugs, or devices are delivered only by the manufacturer or the
- 24 <u>manufacturer's agent and only upon receipt of a physician's order; and</u>
- 25 (5) The manufacturer or manufacturer's agent delivers the dialysate, drugs, or devices
