Chapter 2 of Title 20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to elementary and secondary education, is amended in Code Section 20-2-751.1, relating to expulsion and disciplinary policy for students bringing weapons to school, by revising subsection (a) as follows:

"(a) Each local board of education shall establish a policy, pursuant to this subpart, regarding a student's possession of a firearm, dangerous weapon, or hazardous object at school. With respect to a student who is determined to have possessed a firearm or dangerous weapon at school, such policy shall require expulsion from school for a period of not less than one calendar year; provided, however, that a hearing officer, tribunal, panel, administrator, or superintendent, or local board of education shall have the authority to modify recommend modifications to such expulsion requirement on a case-by-case basis, which must be confirmed by the local board of education. With respect to a student who is determined to have possessed a dangerous weapon at school, such policy shall require expulsion from school for a period determined by the local board of education."

21 SECTION 2.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
