A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Article 2 of Chapter 34 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated,
- 2 relating to medical practice, so as to require physicians to complete continuing education
- 3 training on prescribing controlled substances and the development of addiction; to provide
- 4 for related matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Article 2 of Chapter 34 of Title 43 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 8 medical practice, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 "43-34-46.
- 10 (a) Physicians licensed to practice medicine pursuant to this article shall complete at least
- 11 <u>five hours of continuing education biennially in the ordering and use of controlled</u>
- 12 <u>substances and the risks and indicators regarding development of addiction to controlled</u>
- 13 <u>substances. Physicians shall provide documentation to the board verifying completion of</u>
- such continuing education.
- 15 (b) The requirement contained in this Code section may count toward the biennial
- 16 continuing education requirement contained in paragraph (1) of subsection (a) of Code
- 17 <u>Section 43-34-11.</u>"

18 SECTION 2.

19 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
