

House Bill 590

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

To amend Code Section 47-17-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions relative to the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund, so as to provide that certified jailers shall be eligible for membership in such fund; to provide conditions for an effective date and automatic repeal; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

SECTION 1.

Code Section 47-17-1 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions relative to the Peace Officers' Annuity and Benefit Fund, is amended in paragraph (5) by deleting "and" at the end of subparagraph (J), by replacing the period at the end of subparagraph (K) with "; and", and by adding a new subparagraph at the end to read as follows:

"(L) Jailers certified by the Georgia Peace Officer Standards and Training Council and appointed pursuant to Code Section 42-4-1."

SECTION 2.

This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2016, only if it is determined to have been concurrently funded as provided in Chapter 20 of Title 47 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, the "Public Retirement Systems Standards Law"; otherwise, this Act shall not become effective and shall be automatically repealed in its entirety on July 1, 2016, as required by subsection (a) of Code Section 47-20-50.

SECTION 3.

All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
