AS PASSED SENATE

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Code Section 16-5-70 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 cruelty to children, so as to provide that leaving certain children in vehicles under certain
- 3 circumstances constitutes cruelty to children in the third degree; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Code Section 16-5-70 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to cruelty to
- 8 children, is amended by revising subsection (d) as follows:
- 9 "(d) Any person commits the offense of cruelty to children in the third degree when:
- 10 (1) Such person, who is the primary aggressor, intentionally allows a child under the age
- of 18 to witness the commission of a forcible felony, battery, or family violence battery;
- 12 or
- 13 (2) Such person, who is the primary aggressor, having knowledge that a child under the
- age of 18 is present and sees or hears the act, commits a forcible felony, battery, or family
- violence battery; or
- 16 (3) Such person leaves a child six years of age or younger unattended, or supervised by
- someone who is younger than 13 years of age, in a motor vehicle under circumstances
- that pose a substantial risk of harm to such child's health or safety."

19 SECTION 2.

20 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
