

**ADOPTED**

Representative Powell of the 171<sup>st</sup> offers the following amendment:

1 *Amend HB 375 (LC 29 6387) by deleting line 1 and inserting in lieu thereof the following:*  
2 To amend Code Section 40-2-20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to  
3 registration and license requirements, so as to provide for a temporary operating permit when  
4 a vehicle fails to pass federal emissions standards and certain conditions have been satisfied;  
5 to amend Code Section 40-6-15 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to

6 *By inserting between lines 6 and 7 the following:*  
7 Code Section 40-2-20 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to registration and  
8 license requirements, is amended by adding a new subparagraph to paragraph (1) of  
9 subsection (a) to read as follows:

10 "(C) The county tag agent may issue a temporary operating permit for any vehicle that  
11 fails to comply with applicable federal emission standards, provided that the owner of  
12 such vehicle has provided verification of the existence of minimum motor vehicle  
13 liability insurance coverage and paid all applicable taxes, penalties, insurance lapse  
14 fees, and fees other than the registration fee. Such temporary operating permit shall be  
15 valid for 30 days and shall not be renewable."

16 **SECTION 2.**

17 *By replacing "2" on line 17 with "3".*
