Senator Hill of the 6th offers the following amendment:

1 *Amend SB 154 (LC 29 6390) by inserting after "definition;" on line 6 the following:*

2 to amend Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when
3 public disclosure of agency records is not required, so as to change certain provisions relating
4 to the release of certain audio and video recordings;

5 *By inserting between lines 56 and 57 the following:*

6 **SECTION 3A.**

7 Code Section 50-18-72 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to when public
8 disclosure of agency records is not required, is amended in subsection (a) by adding a new
9 paragraph to read as follows:

10 "(26.2) Audio and video recordings from devices used by law enforcement officers,
11 except to the following, provided that the person seeking the audio or video recording
12 submits a sworn affidavit that attests to the facts necessary to establish eligibility under
13 this paragraph:

14 (A) A duly appointed representative of a deceased's estate when the decedent was
15 depicted or heard on such recording;

16 (B) A parent or legal guardian of a minor depicted or heard on such recording;

17 (C) An accused in a criminal case when, in the good faith belief of the accused, such
18 recording is relevant to his or her criminal proceeding;

19 (D) A party to a civil action when, in the good faith belief of such party, such recording
20 is relevant to the civil action;

21 (E) An attorney for any of the persons identified in subparagraphs (A) through (D) of
22 this paragraph; or

23 (F) An attorney for a person who may pursue a civil action when, in the good faith
24 belief of such attorney, such recording is relevant to the potential civil action;"
