A RESOLUTION

1 Commending the Camp Dream Foundation on its 20th anniversary and recognizing March
2 18, 2015, as Camp Dream Day; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, Camp Dream, a summer camp for mild to severely disabled children and young
4 adults located in Warm Springs, Georgia, at the Roosevelt Institute for Rehabilitation, will
5 mark the 20th year its campers have been able to experience a program unlike any other in
6 Georgia; and

7 WHEREAS, approximately 175-225 campers from over 40 Georgia counties come to Camp
8 Dream every summer; and

9 WHEREAS, campers receive a true summer camp experience that includes fishing,
10 horseback riding, swimming, boating, campfires, and even a motorcycle ride or two; and

11 WHEREAS, Camp Dream has a one-to-one camper to counselor ratio, which not many
12 camps in the country are able to boast; and

13 WHEREAS, summer camp sessions are 100 percent volunteer driven at Camp Dream, and
14 Camp Directors, Counselors, and camp staff are all volunteers, with many taking vacation
15 time from their jobs to operate the camp.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body commend the Camp Dream Foundation on its 20th anniversary and
18 recognize March 18, 2015, as Camp Dream Day.
