A RESOLUTION

1 Commending men and women in radio broadcasting and recognizing April 21-25, 2015, as
2 Men and Women in Radio Broadcasting Week in the State of Georgia; and for other
3 purposes.

4 WHEREAS, men and women in radio broadcasting are the producers of radio shows, station
5 managers, disc jockeys, radio hosts, and traffic reporters for blog talk radio, internet radio,
6 podcasts, and everyone who works behind the scenes; and

7 WHEREAS, they have made many invaluable accomplishments and contributions to the
8 State of Georgia; in the early years, radio was the medium that kept the country informed on
9 what was going on in the world, and it is just as important today; and

10 WHEREAS, such talented individuals over the years have brought to their listening audience
11 music, weather, news, and commentary; radio has enlightened and encouraged debate on
12 issues that affect all citizens; and

13 WHEREAS, on January 12, 2015, the first day of the 2015 legislative session, the men and
14 women in radio broadcasting were recognized at the capitol; they conducted live broadcasts
15 while interviewing legislators and visitors inside of the capitol.

16 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
17 the members of this body commend men and women in radio broadcasting and recognize
18 April 21-25, 2015, as Men and Women in Radio Broadcasting Week in the State of Georgia.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the House of Representatives is authorized
20 and directed to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to men
21 and women in radio broadcasting.
