## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

- 1 To amend Chapter 24 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to
- 2 insurance general provisions, so as to provide reimbursement for the treatment of burns for
- 3 skin substitutes utilizing cryopreserved cadaver derived skin tissue; to provide for related
- 4 matters; to repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

## 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

6 SECTION 1.

- 7 Chapter 24 of Title 33 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to insurance
- 8 general provisions, is amended by adding a new Code section to read as follows:
- 9 <u>"33-24-59.18.</u>
- No health benefit policy issued, delivered, or renewed in this state that, as a provision of
- 11 <u>hospital, medical, or surgical services, directly or indirectly covers the treatment and</u>
- 12 management of burns shall limit or exclude coverage for such treatment on the basis that
- 13 the use of cryopreserved cadaver derived skin tissue is an experimental or investigational
- 14 <u>medical treatment.</u>"

15 SECTION 2.

16 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
