A RESOLUTION

1 Recognizing and commending First Sergeant Robert Patrick Brady on the grand occasion of
2 his retirement; and for other purposes.

3 WHEREAS, First Sergeant Robert Patrick Brady entered the Army in August, 1984, and
4 graduated One Station Unit Training at Fort Benning, Georgia, as an Infantryman, and in
5 1990, prior to Desert Storm, First Sergeant Brady attended Advanced Individual Training and
6 earned a second Military Occupational Specialty of 68W; and

7 WHEREAS, during his 31 years of service, First Sergeant Brady has held numerous
8 positions, including Automatic Rifleman, Grenadier, Team Leader, Squad Leader, Medical
9 Section Chief, Evacuation Section Sergeant, Platoon Sergeant, Advanced Individual Training
10 Instructor, and Senior Operations NCO; and

11 WHEREAS, his previous assignments include C Company (Airborne) 6th Battalion 327th
12 Infantry Fort Wainwright, 2291st United States Army General Hospital and 914th Combat
13 Support Hospital Whitehall, Ohio, 2nd Squadron 4th United States Cavalry and 3rd Squadron
14 7th United States Cavalry Fort Stewart, 1st Battalion, (Attack) 3rd Aviation Regiment Hunter
15 Army Airfield, G Company 232nd Medical Battalion, Fort Sam Houston, and C Company
16 626 Brigade Support Battalion, 3rd Battalion 320th Field Artillery, 1st Battalion 187th
17 Infantry, which are all located at Fort Campbell; and in November, 2013, Robert Brady was
18 assigned as the First Sergeant of Bravo Company, 86th Combat Support Hospital, Fort
19 Campbell, Kentucky; and

20 WHEREAS, First Sergeant Brady's military and civilian education include Airborne Course,
21 Warrior Leader Course, Advanced Leader Course, Senior Leaders Course, Cadre Training
22 Course, Small Group Facilitators Course, Instructors Course, Brigade Combat Trauma Team
23 Training Course, Installation Emergency Management Planning Course, and First Sergeant
24 Course, and he is a Nationally Registered Paramedic, holds an Associate of Science in Health
25 Science, and is pursuing a Bachelor of Science in Emergency Management Degree; and

26 WHEREAS, his military awards and decorations include the Bronze Star Medal with two
27 Oak Leaf Clusters, Meritorious Service Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, Army
28 Commendation Medal with two Oak Leaf Clusters, Army Achievement Medal with four Oak
29 Leaf Clusters, Afghan Campaign Medal with one Campaign Star, Iraq Campaign Medal with
30 two Campaign Stars, Expert Field Medical Badge, Parachutist Badge, and the Combat Medic
31 Badge; and

32 WHEREAS, First Sergeant Brady is married and has three children; and

33 WHEREAS, he is a person of magnanimous strengths with an unimpeachable reputation for
34 integrity, intelligence, fairness, and kindness; and

35 WHEREAS, First Sergeant Brady has served with honor and distinction with the United
36 States Army, and his vision and unyielding commitment will be sorely missed upon the
37 occasion of his retirement; and

38 WHEREAS, it is abundantly fitting and proper that the outstanding accomplishments of this
39 remarkable and distinguished Georgian be appropriately recognized.

40 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body
41 congratulate First Sergeant Robert Patrick Brady upon the grand occasion of his retirement
