A BILL TO BE ENTITLED AN ACT

1 To amend Code Section 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to 2 definitions for juvenile proceedings under the Juvenile Code, so as to provide that minor 3 violations of weapons in school safety zones are not considered Class B designated felonies; 4 to restore certain provisions to their prior form due to the conflict between the enactment of 5 2014 House Bill 60 and House Bill 826; to amend Code Section 20-2-1184 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to reporting of students committing prohibited acts, so 6 7 as to limit the reporting of certain acts; to provide for related matters; to repeal conflicting 8 laws; and for other purposes. 9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA: 10 **SECTION 1.** 11 Code Section 15-11-2 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to definitions for 12 juvenile proceedings, is amended by revising subparagraph (N) of paragraph (13) as follows: 13 "(N)(i) An act which constitutes a violation of Code Section 16-11-127.1 involving 14 <u>a:</u> 15 (I) Firearm, as defined in Code Section 16-11-131; 16 (II) Dangerous weapon or machine gun, as defined in Code Section 16-11-121; or 17 (III) Weapon, as defined in Code Section 16-11-127.1, together with an assault; or 18 (ii) An act which constitutes a second or subsequent adjudication of delinquency 19 based on a violation of Code Section 16-11-127.1; or" 20 **SECTION 2.** 21 Code Section 20-2-1184 of the Official Code of Georgia Annotated, relating to reporting of students committing prohibited acts, is amended by revising subsection (a) as follows: 22

"(a) Any teacher or other person employed at any public or private elementary or
secondary school or any dean or public safety officer employed by a college or university
who has reasonable cause to believe that a student at that school has committed any act
upon school property or at any school function, which act is prohibited by Code Section

27	16-5-21 or 16-5-24, Chapter 6 of Title 16, and Code Section 16-11-127, 16-11-127.1,
28	16-11-132, or 16-13-30, shall immediately report the act and the name of the student to the

- 29 principal or president of that school or the principal's or president's designee<u>: provided.</u>
- 30 <u>however, that an act which is prohibited by Code Section 16-11-127.1 shall be reported</u>
- 31 <u>only when it involves a:</u>
- 32 (1) Firearm, as defined in Code Section 16-11-131;
- 33 (2) Dangerous weapon or machine gun, as defined in Code Section 16-11-121; or
- 34 (3) Weapon, as defined in Code Section 16-11-127.1, together with an assault."

SECTION 3.

36 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
