19 him to achieve his utmost potential; and

20 WHEREAS, he has personified the selfless dedication, mental agility, verbal adroitness, and
21 personal maturity necessary for superlative academic performance; and

22 WHEREAS, the State of Georgia looks with great anticipation toward the future of this
23 bright and promising young citizen.
