## BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

## 5 SECTION 1. 6 All elections for the office of chief magistrate of Crisp County shall be nonpartisan elections 7 as provided for in Code Section 21-2-139 of the O.C.G.A. Such nonpartisan election shall 8 be held at the nonpartisan general election immediately preceding the expiration of the term 9 of office of such chief magistrate and shall be conducted as provided in Chapter 2 of Title 10 21 of the O.C.G.A., the "Georgia Election Code."

11SECTION 2.12Nothing in this Act shall affect the term of office of the chief magistrate of Crisp County in13office on July 1, 2015. The sitting chief magistrate shall serve out the term of office for14which he or she was elected and shall be eligible to succeed himself or herself as provided15in this Act.
