- 2 WHEREAS, Michael Green has been deaf since birth and has used a Cochlear Implant since
3 he was six years old; he has overcome his disability in a manner which is an inspiration to
4 all who suffer the same disability; and
- 5 WHEREAS, Michael has been trained at Auditory Verbal Center in Atlanta to the point that
6 he speaks clearly and read lips succinctly and does not need to use sign language; and
- 7 WHEREAS, Michael has received the Mercer University Outstanding Student in Finance
8 Award for the highest grade point average in 2014; and
- 9 WHEREAS, he was recognized with Mercer Student Leadership Award in 2014; and
- 10 WHEREAS, he was inducted into the Order of Omega in 2013 as a Greek Leader; and
- 11 WHEREAS, Michael graduated Cum Laude from Mercer University in 2014; and
- 12 WHEREAS, he was inducted into the Financial Management Association International
13 National Honor Society in 2014; and
- 14 WHEREAS, Michael's academic record at Mercer University resulted in his being named to
15 the President's List and the Dean's List for six semesters; and
- 16 WHEREAS, he was awarded a Mercer Wrestling Scholarship, a Sertoma Scholarship, a
17 Mercer Academic Scholarship, and the HOPE Scholarship; and
- 18 WHEREAS, Michael displayed his athletic abilities through the sport of wrestling and was
19 recognized with the Mercer "Tough Man" and Coach's Award in 2009; and

20 WHEREAS, he has sought to serve fellow students by tutoring them in accounting, statistics,
21 and finance; and

22 WHEREAS, Kelley Green, Laura and Roger Green, and his entire family are greatly pleased
23 with what Michael has accomplished given the power of God that operates through him.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES that
25 the members of this body commend Roger Michael Green for overcoming his disability in
26 a manner that is an inspiration to all who suffer the same disability.
