19 Authority, is the Captain for the 2014 Lowndes American Heart Walk, chairman of the  
20 Cancer Coalition of South Georgia Board of Directors, the South Georgia Medical Center  
21 Foundation Board, the Wiregrass Georgia Technical College Board of Trustees, is the  
22 Governor's appointee to the Southern Georgia Regional Commission Council, and is a  
23 member of the Valdosta Rotary Club; and

24 WHEREAS, she is united in marriage to Jerry, and they are blessed with a remarkable  
25 daughter, Amanda; and

26 WHEREAS, Ms. Lupo's significant organizational and leadership talents, her remarkable
