## A RESOLUTION

- 1 Recognizing March 24, 2015, as Georgia Law School Day; and for other purposes.
- 2 WHEREAS, Georgia Law School was founded in 1859 and has the distinction of being the  
3 oldest operating law school in Georgia; and
- 4 WHEREAS, this acclaimed institution produces three highly regarded journals of legal  
5 scholarship: *Georgia Law Review*, *Georgia Journal of International and Comparative Law*,  
6 and *Journal of Intellectual Property Law*; and
- 7 WHEREAS, the mock trial and moot court programs have been recognized as some of the  
8 best in the country; the law school's moot court program has won five national titles, 11  
9 regional championships, and five state trophies over the past six years, recently winning the  
10 64th Annual National Moot Court Competition; and
- 11 WHEREAS, it is widely recognized as one of the best law schools in the country and, in an  
12 environment of continuously rising costs of legal education, one of the best values in legal  
13 education, thanks to support from state legislators; and
- 14 WHEREAS, distinguished alumni of the school include numerous state legislators, former  
15 Governors, and United States Representatives and Senators; and
- 16 WHEREAS, Georgia Law School Day at the capitol is organized and supported entirely by  
17 student members of the Georgia Association of Law and Politics and the Student Bar  
18 Association.
- 19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE that the members of this body  
20 recognize March 24, 2015, as Georgia Law School Day at the capitol.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Secretary of the Senate is authorized and directed  
22 to make appropriate copies of this resolution available for distribution to the Georgia Law  
23 School.
