A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act providing for the appointment of the chief magistrate of Clayton County,
2 approved March 21, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4411), as amended, particularly by an Act
3 approved May 4, 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, p. 4136), so as to change the salary of the chief
4 magistrate; to provide for related matters; to provide for an effective date; to repeal
5 conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act providing for the appointment of the chief magistrate of Clayton County, approved
9 March 21, 1984 (Ga. L. 1984, p. 4411), as amended, particularly by an Act approved May 4,
10 2006 (Ga. L. 2006, p. 4136), is amended by revising subsection (f) of Section 2 as follows:
11 "(f) The chief magistrate of Clayton County shall receive an annual salary of \$115,460.00.
12 Such salary shall be increased in an amount equal to 85 percent of any increase in the
13 county supplement paid to the judges of the Clayton Judicial Circuit. Such salary shall be
14 paid in equal monthly installments from the funds of Clayton County."

15 **SECTION 2.**

16 This Act shall become effective on July 1, 2015.

17 **SECTION 3.**

18 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
