

House Bill 576 (AS PASSED HOUSE AND SENATE)

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT

1 To amend an Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Broxton, Georgia,
2 in the County of Coffee," approved April 6, 1981 (Ga. L. 1981, p. 3597), as amended,
3 particularly by an Act approved April 6, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5320), so as to provide for
4 four-year terms for the mayor and members of the city council; to provide for elections; to
5 repeal conflicting laws; and for other purposes.

6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE GENERAL ASSEMBLY OF GEORGIA:

7 **SECTION 1.**

8 An Act entitled "An Act to provide a new charter for the City of Broxton, Georgia, in the
9 County of Coffee," approved April 6, 1981 (Ga. L. 1981, p. 3597), as amended, particularly
10 by an Act approved April 6, 1992 (Ga. L. 1992, p. 5320), is amended by revising subsection
11 (a) of Section 2.2 as follows:

12 "(a) The mayor and members of the city council shall serve terms of four years and until
13 their successors are duly elected and qualified."

14 **SECTION 2.**

15 Said Act is further amended by revising Section 3.3 as follows:

16 "Section 3.3. Time of Elections. The mayor and four council members serving on the
17 effective date of this Act shall complete their terms on December 31, 2015, and shall serve
18 until their successors are elected and qualified. On the Tuesday next following the first
19 Monday in November, 2015, and quadrennially thereafter, an election shall be held for the
20 office of mayor and the offices of the four council members. The persons elected at such
21 election shall take office on January 1 of the year following their election and shall serve
22 terms of four years and until their successors are elected and qualified."

SECTION 3.

24 All laws and parts of laws in conflict with this Act are repealed.
